CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

Participants must be employed or actively engaged in the field of education and/or work in the area of at-risk youth services (or similar setting).

Program Registration: \$450

Please note the program registration fee must be received by NDPC within 30 days of applicant's participation in a qualifying NDPC conference or other NDPC event or within 30 days of registering for one or more 15 Effective Strategies for Dropout Prevention online courses. Fee includes one-year NDPC membership plus discounts on NDPC services and products. Event fees, travel and associated costs, and online course costs are the responsibility of the participant.

Online Courses: \$99 per course*

*Exception: the Overview Course carries two credits and costs \$149.

Upon acceptance, candidates must:

- Complete the NDPS professional learning requirements within 24 months (online courses must be completed within 12 months of registration in the course)
- Maintain continuous membership with the National Dropout Prevention Center after initial membership year concludes, and
- Submit and share a field project.

Because online courses are self-paced, many participants complete the program more quickly than two years. Professional learning requirements are to attend at least twelve designated sessions at NDPC conferences or to complete twelve National Dropout Prevention Center online courses or any combination that totals twelve. Strategies may not be repeated.

Certification is valid for three years and may be renewed by continuing NDPC membership and attending four additional NDPC conference sessions, completing four NDPC online courses, or a combination of both that totals four for certification renewal.



CERTIFICATION BENEFITS

Certificate holders will receive documentation of current and research-based expertise in multiple areas of dropout prevention and at-risk youth services from the NDPC, the nation's leading dropout prevention organization.

Certificate holders will be recognized on our website as having completed the program and may make themselves available to share their expertise with school districts and related professionals seeking counsel on dropout prevention. Being networked to other front-line practitioners gives our graduates unique opportunities for collaboration and to share information nationwide.

Other benefits include NDPC posting of field project reports and receiving all discounts offered to individuals enrolled in NDPC membership during program participation.


Candidates for certification must then complete a field project report to validate their on-the-job experience. Approved field project reports will be published on the NDPC website.
